



MOHICAN *With Two F*

Mohican State Park & Forest

Over 12 thousand years ago the Wisconsin Glacier carved Mohican State Park and Forest from the Ohio landscape. Today the park and forest are an outdoor lover's paradise, with nearly 6,000 acres of rugged woodlands. Rocky outcroppings line the hillsides, where melting snow in the spring creates cascading waterfalls and trickles toward the Clear Fork River as it winds through the valley far below. In the autumn, the trees are ablaze with some of the most spectacular foliage in the state.

Many come to Mohican for over 45 miles of scenic hiking trails - several with trailheads near the iconic Covered Bridge in the heart of the park. Hikers of all skill levels will enjoy trails ranging from easy to difficult. The most popular is a two-mile path beginning at the Covered Bridge leading to Big and Little Lyons Falls.

Others enjoy the shady forest on horseback along 3 beautiful bridle trails. Love the winter? Mohican has great trails for snowmobiling and cross-country skiing. Mountain bike enthusiasts flock to Mohican for what insiders consider the best track in Ohio. The 25-mile continuous loop through the forest will challenge the best riders with its changes in elevation.

Mohican State Park and Forest is a fabulous destination for anyone who wants to sightsee, plan a picnic, or enjoy its plants and wildlife. One can't-miss attraction is the Gorge Overlook, a Registered National Natural Landmark. The observation area offers a stunning view of the moss-covered boulders and collection of Hemlocks that surround Clearfork Gorge, which is over a
