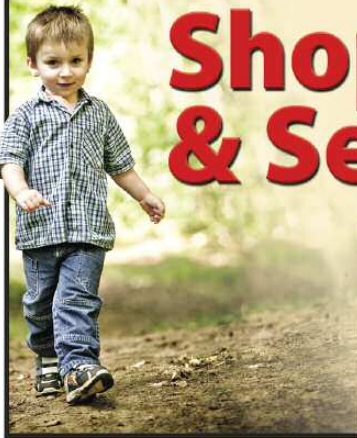


# Shopping & Services
